



# Safety and maintenance matters



### 1. Important safety warnings

- \* Do not allow children to approach the movable range of the chair.
- \* Use grounded power supply which matches this chair to prevent the risk of electric shock.
- \* Pull out the power plug after use or before cleaning, so as not to cause equipment or personal damage.
- \* Please follow the instructions in this operation manual.
- \* Do not use unrecommended accessories and components.
- \* Do not use this chair outdoors.
- \* Please read this manual carefully before use.
- \* Do not use this chair for other purposes not listed in this manual.
- \* Do not use this chair if the outer shell or the case of this chair is damaged.
- $\mbox{\%}$  Do not cover the heat emission hole with any articles.
- $\ensuremath{\,\times\,}$  Do not let anything fall into this chair.
- \* Do not use this chair when drunk or uncomfortable.
- ※ Do not use this chair within one hour after meal.
- $\ensuremath{\%}$  Do not exert excessive force in order to avoid injury.



### 2. Use environment

- Do not use the chair in hot and humid environment (bathroom)
- $\ensuremath{\mathbb{X}}$  Place the chair on a flat surface, so as not to cause dumping.
- **X** Accidents
- $\ensuremath{\mathbb{X}}$  Do not use the chair in the environment with severe dust or corrosive gases
- X Do not smoke on this chair in order to avoid burning the leather case.

### 3. Unsuitable crowds

- Severe osteoporosis patients
- $\ensuremath{\mathbb{X}}$  Persons wearing electronic medical device such as pacemaker
- ※ Persons with high fever
- ※ Pregnant or menstrual women
- X Children under 14 years old and without supervision, and mentally retarded persons
- \* Persons needing recuperation at doctor's behest or feeling illness
- ※ Persons with wet body

### 4. Safety matters

- \* Check whether the voltage meets the specification requirements.
- \* Do not plug or unplug the power plug with wet hands.
- \* Do not enter water into the chair in order to avoid electric shock or damage.
- \* Do not pull or drag the power cord when plugging or unplugging the power plug. Do not be rough.
- \* Do not damage or change the wiring circuit of the chair.
- \* In case of power outage, do not use the chair so as not to cause injury when the power suddenly restores.
- \* In case of abnormal situation, stop using the chair immediately and consult with local service provider.
- \* This chair cannot be used for persons with physical disabilities, sensory or neurological deficiencies or lack of experience and common sense (including children), unless they are supervised and guided by the persons responsible for their safety.
- $\ensuremath{\mathbb{X}}$  Children must be supervised to ensure that they will not play with the chair.
- \* If the soft wire of power supply is damaged, it must be replaced by the professional personnel of the manufacturer's maintenance department or other similar departments in order to avoid danger.





### 5. Repair and maintenance

- \*\* (Do not use diluent, benzene or alcohol, detergent to clean the chair so as not to cause damage to the leather case). Clean with dry cloth and professional leather detergent.
- \* The chair can only be repaired by the service center designated by the manufacturer. Users cannot disassemble or repair the chair without permission.
- \* Please remember to turn off the main power after use.
- \* Do not use this chair when the power socket is loose.
- ※ If the chair is not used for a long time, the power cord should be rolled up and the chair should be stored in a dry and dustless environment.
- \* Do not store the chair nearby high temperature environment or open fire. Avoid direct sunshine for a long time
- \* The mechanical device of this chair is specially designed and manufactured. It is free of special maintenance.
- \* Do not stab the chair with sharp objects.
- $\ensuremath{\mathbb{X}}$  Do not roll or drag the chair on uneven ground. It should be lifted when moving.
- \* Use the chair intermittently. Avoid long-term continuous use.


# Functions, Efficacy and Components



### **Main Components**

### **Function and efficacy**

- ▲ L-shaped long guide rail, covering the head, neck, shoulder, back, spine, waist and buttock;
- ▲ Back to the mute simulation manipulator, moving up and down for massage;
- ▲Six simulation massage modes: kneading, tapping, flapping, finger pressing, kneading and tapping, kneading and flapping;
- ▲ Six automatic intelligent massage modes, multi-function selection, making massage more comfortable;
- ▲Air pressure massage function for shoulder, arms, buttock, legs and feet;
- ▲ Backrest heating function;

- $\blacktriangle Finger pressing with foot rollers, and squeezing with foot balloons.$





### Unpack

Lift up the outer case, remove the fixed posts, and take out the operation manual, power cord and other accessories.



# Installation of massage chair

### Moving the massage chair

As shown in the right picture, tilt the chair back about 45 degrees and push it forward or backward with the casters until it is placed at the right position.


### Note!

- \* Do not move the massage chair when there is someone lying on it.
- \* When moving the massage chair, it is suggested to put a mat under the product in order to avoid damage to the floor.
- \* In order to avoid falling, firmly hold the massage chair when moving.

### Placing the massage chair

When placing the massage chair, leave enough space around the chair so that the leg and back of the chair can be lifted up and down freely. It is suggested to place the massage chair as shown in the right figure.

# Operation instructions

### **Automatic mode**

AUTO key or automatic program selected in the menu interface.

There are six automatic modes for users to select.

1. common massage 2. fatigue recovery 3. pain improvement 4. sleep mode 5. stretching 6. health and leisure The other automatic modes ("AUTO" key) and manual mode can be switched before the end of one automatic program. In automatic mode, the functions of turning on and turning off, air pressure increase or decrease, and roller operation can be selected. The icons of the current massage program flash in the LCD screen.

### Manual mode

Manual Program in the Menu Interface

- 1. Massage techniques: flapping, kneading and flapping, kneading and tapping, kneading, finger pressing, tapping
- 2. Massage speed: weak, medium and strong
- 3. Massage range: wide, medium and narrow (adjust the position of massage head)
- 4. Massage sites: fixed point, whole body, shoulder and waist (select the massage sites)
- 5. Roller switch: turn on or turn off the roller mode
- 6. Roller speed: weak, medium and strong (select roller speed to massage foot sole)
- 7. Strengthening switch: turn on or turn off the back heating

# Fault handling

# Regulations on After-sales Service and Quality Assurance

### I. After-sales Commitment

- 1. The free warranty period is 3 years (36 months).
- 2. The free warranty period shall be depend on the valid purchase invoice issued by the seller.
- 3. During the free warranty period, users must hold the free warranty certificates, including warranty card, product serial number when repairing and maintaining the product.
- 5. During the free warranty period, the product repair time should be determined according to the actual situation.
- 6. The warranty clause is only applicable to the original purchaser, and is not transferred with the resale or lease of the product.
- 7. After the product is repaired, the warranty period will be calculated according to the remaining time of the warranty period, or the warranty period is limited to 100 days. The longer warranty period prevails.
- 8. During the non-warranty period, users will be charged for product maintenance according to the fee standard stipulated in the "Paid Service Manual".



- II. Within the free warranty period, the company refuses to provide services or charges service fee at its discretion in the following circumstances.
- 1. The user did not show the warranty card or the warranty card was not filled in clearly (There is omission or alteration, especially the "product serial number" was removed, damaged or altered).
- 2. Product failure and damage caused by user's misoperation or improper use.
- 3. Failure caused by users who disassemble, modify or change the design without authorization of our company.
- 4. Failure caused by the user's self-transportation after purchasing.
- 5. Damage caused by natural disasters such as lightning, fire or earthquake.

### III. Notes for Maintenance

- 1. If the warranty information, product function or product specifications are changed, our company will not give notices.
- 2. The warranty card comes into effect until it is stamped by the seller.
- 3. Our company reserves the right to interpret the above terms.
