




(1) Unpack the carton and take all massage chair units out of the carton.





- 1.1. Remove secure straps and lift the carton vertically.

(2) Calf installation process
























(3) Install tablet holder

Insert the lower end of tablet holder into the socket and turn clockwise to secure the holder into place. Use an allen key to tighten the remote control bracket.



(4) Placing the massage chair


- *Carry the massage chair out of the carton and place at a desired location.
- *Do not put this product near heat source, open flame or in direct sunlight.
- *This may cause fading or damage.
- *The bottom of the massage chair may scratch the floor, we recommend placing a piece of carpet or soft mat underneath it to avoid damaging the floor.
- *Please allocate clearance to the front and back(a minimum 25-centimeter clearance behind the backrest) of the product;
- *Do not put the massage chair in high moisture environment or on uneven unleveled floor.
- *Keep it 1 meter away from the TV, radio or other audio/video appliance to avoid signal interference.







(5) Connect to power

Plug the power cord into the chair and connect to the power outlet, turn on the main power switch, you are set to go.

Moving the Massage Chair

- Push down on the backrest and tilt the chair about
 30°(see left figure).
- 2. Roll the chair on its casters to the desired location.



Back of massage chair




Antipinch device: The massage chair will stop reclining automatically when any foreign objects [such as pet or children] are sensed, it will continue to recline when foreign object is removed.

Press this button to cycle through the heating of the waist, legs, waist and legs simultaneously, and turn off the heating.

Seat Adjustment

How to Use

1. Power On Interface

Press the "o" button on the remote control to power on. Enter the power on interface, select the corresponding icon, and enter the corresponding operating mode.



2. Startup Procedure

Once powered on, the massage chair will initiate a self-check process on its interface.



3. Smart Posture Detection

Upon startup, the chair initiates the smart posture detection process. This function automatically adapts the massage position to the user's body size for optimal comfort. Press " \bigcirc " to pause the detection, " \bigcirc " to skip it, and " \bigcirc " " to power down directly.



4. Shoulder Position Detection

After the posture detection is completed, the massage chair will automatically enter the shoulder position detection. Then, use the "Up/Down" buttons to control the upward and downward movement of the rollers. When the rollers are in the ideal position, press " ok "to confirm the position, " \bigcirc " to pause the detection, " \bigcirc " to skip the detection, and " \bigcirc " to shut down directly.

5. Technique

In manual mode, press the "Technique" button to choose from the techniques and three massage intensities. 4D Method combined with other Trchnique, The lower part allows manual adjustment of Technique, Focus Zone, Airbegs Massage.



6. Focus Zone

In manual mode, press the "Focus Zone" button to choose among Spot, Region, Whole Body. The position of the massage balls can be adjusted up and down using " und "



7. Airbag Massage

Enter the manual mode and select from various airbag positions for Calf, Buttick, Arm, and shoulder.



8. Al Voice Control

Click to turn AI voice control on or off.

9. Settings

Enter the settings interface to adjust brightness levels, button sound volume, Bluetooth on/off, LED light on/off, screen Closure time, Time of massage , and choose from four language options.

10. Shutdown Interface

Click " (b) " to enter the shutdown interface and perform massage chair reset.



Flat Button Functions Description



Power On/Off Key

Press this key to enter the power on state. Press again to turn off the device.

Panel Automatic Programs Description



Smart Massage: Five automatic programs targeting different body areas, including Shoulder & Neck & Neck, Waist & Hip Massage, Spine Care, Joint Care, Leg Care, etc.





Spine Care: Unique massage techniques targeting the spine, effectively relieving spinal soreness and improving spine fatigue.

Joint Care: Unique massage techniques targeting the joints, effectively relieving joint soreness and improving joint fatigue.

Leg Care: Unique massage techniques targeting the legs, effectively relieving leg soreness and improving leg fatigue.



Health Care: Five automatic programs simulating various scenarios from daily life, including Stress Relieving, Energy, Deep Massage, Sports Recovery, Brain Refresh, etc.

- $Stress\,Relieving: Gentle\,massage\,strength.\,Comforts\,the\,whole\,body, promotes\,blood$ circulation, relaxes the body and mind, effectively relieves various discomforts caused by long and continuous work, and eliminates overall fatigue.

Comfort Massage: Moderate massage strength, specially designed for female users, providing a massage program that shapes a graceful and light figure without burden.



Quick Massage: Quick and precise combination massage, saving time and relaxing the body.



Stretch Massage: Full-body stretching to cater to users who need to stretch their muscles, relieving fatigue and restoring body vitality and flexibility.



Shiatsu Massage: Utilizing kneading and acupressure massage techniques, as if gentle hands are providing a deep massage to soothe weariness and tension.



Airbag Massage: Gentle and sequential compression by airbags, progressively providing deep relaxation and decompression throughout the entire body.



VIP: Four sets of simulated automatic modes for different usage scenarios, including Good-night Sleep, Yoga Massage, Office Regimen, and TV Mode.



Good-night Sleep: Gentle massage with coordinated backrest elevation and rocking, alleviating fatigue and promoting a restful sleep, easing tension for a serene slumber.



Yoga Massage: Incorporates stretching movements for the body and legs, suitable for users who need to stretch their entire body muscles, providing moderate pressure to effectively restore body vitality and flexibility.



Office Regimen: Delicate massage with gentle strokes covering the entire body, promoting blood circulation, and inducing relaxation.



TV Mode: Soft massage suitable for older users, effectively rejuvenating the body and improving blood circulation.



Special: Three sets of simulated automatic modes featuring different massage techniques from various countries, including Thai Massage, Chinese Massage, and Swedish Massage.



Thai Massage: Simulates the techniques used in Thai massage, with a stronger intensity, providing a relaxing experience for the entire body.



Chinese Massage: Applies moderate pressure and combines various Chinese Tui Na techniques, such as acupressure, kneading, tapping, and patting, to deeply relax the muscles of the back.

Armrest Control Function Description




- Refer to page 6 for the shortcut key: Press and hold this key for 3 seconds to power on or power off the massage chair.
- After powering on, Short press to pause massage, then short press to resume massage



 After powering on, rotate the knob clockwise to raise the backrest; rotate it counterclockwise to lower the backrest.



- *When adjusting the leg massage component, please do not sit in the massage chair. Pressing down suddenly on the leg component can cause damage to the mechanism.
- * Moreover, it may even cause the chair to overturn, resulting in unexpected injuries.
- $* \ Before sitting in the massage chair, please ensure that the backrest is in an upright position. Adjust the recline angle according to personal preferences after sitting.\\$
- *Do not place hands or objects in the gap between the seat and the leg component to prevent potential injuries.
- $*\ When adjusting the angle, make sure there are no obstacles or small animals behind or under the backrest and leg component.$



- *Press the power switch at the armrest to stop all massage motions.
- *When not in use for a long period of time, be sure to turn off the power switch.
- *Disconnect the power cord from the electrical outlet.
- *Do not drag the power cord to avoid damage to the cord, leading to fire or electric shock.


10 Abnormalities and handling methods

Check whether the power cord is damaged. Check that the fuse is damaged and replace the fuse. Check whether the manual control line is inserted well and screwed
The backrest cannot be raised and lowered freely.	Check whether there are foreign objects stuck in the backrest and lower legs. Check whether the connecting wire is loose.
During use, the controller can be operated, but the massage chair cannot be operated.	After a long period of operation, if the temperature of the machine is too high, the massage chair will It is automatically in the temperature protection state, please turn off the powerand use it for 30 to 50 minutes to let the internal heat dissipation of the machine.
During use, the controller cannot be operated, and the massage chair also stops operating	After the automatic timing function is activated. If the set time is up, please press the button again to control it.

Do not use steel wool, abrasive cleaners or corrosive liquids (such as gasoline or acetone) to clean the product.


- 1 Unplug the plug from the power socket.
